Notice of Deadline for Filing Claims: FEBRUARY 3, 2025

**YOU MAY HAVE A SEXUAL ABUSE CLAIM OR OTHER CLAIM AGAINST THE DIOCESE OF
SAN DIEGO**

On June 17, 2024, The Roman Catholic Bishop of San Diego, sometimes referred to as The Diocese of San Diego (“Debtor”) filed for protection under chapter 11 of Title 11 of the United States Code (the “Bankruptcy Code”).

If you were sexually abused by any person connected with Debtor, you must file a claim so as to be received by February 3, 2025, or otherwise you will be forever barred, estopped, and enjoined from asserting such claim against the Debtor. Even if you have already filed a lawsuit against Debtor alleging abuse you must still file a claim to maintain and/or preserve your rights.

Claims based on acts or omissions of the Debtor that occurred before June 17, 2024, must be filed on or before February 3, 2025, even if such claims are not now fixed, liquidated, or certain or did not mature or become fixed, liquidated, or certain before June 17, 2024.

ES POSIBLE QUE TENGA UNA RECLAMACIÓN POR ABUSO SEXUAL U OTRA RECLAMACIÓN CONTRA LA DIÓCESIS DE SAN DIEGO

El 17 de junio del 2024, la Diócesis de San Diego (“Deudor”) solicitó protección en virtud del Capítulo 11 del Título 11 del Código de los Estados Unidos (el “Código de Bancarrota”).

Si fue víctima de abuso sexual por parte de cualquier persona relacionada con el Deudor, debe presentar una reclamación para que se reciba antes del 3 de febrero del 2025 o, de lo contrario, se le prohibirá, impedirá y restringirá presentar este tipo de reclamaciones contra el Deudor para siempre. Incluso si ya presentó una demanda contra el Deudor por abuso, debe presentar una reclamación para mantener o preservar sus derechos.

Las reclamaciones basadas en actos u omisiones del Deudor que ocurrieron antes del 17 de junio del 2024 deben presentarse el 3 de febrero del 2025 o antes, incluso si dichas reclamaciones no se han solucionado, liquidado o determinado o no vencieron ni se solucionaron, liquidaron o determinaron antes del 17 de junio del 2024.

3RD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

LUKE 1:1-4, 4:14-21



A young couple in my parish told me they were expecting their second child, a baby boy. I knew that their five-year old only child Emma had been desperately wanting to

be a big sister for years, so I said, “Emma must have been so happy when you told her the news.” “Actually,” they said, “she burst into tears. She wanted a baby sister!” How often in life God wonderfully fulfills our desires and we are sad because we don’t approve of the way he does it. We want to control the gift and the delivery method.

The same thing occurs in the Gospel this week when Jesus announces in his hometown that the promise of an Anointed One bringing glad tidings to the poor is “fulfilled in your hearing” (Luke 4:21). After a moment of elation, his fellow townsfolk realize this man is the way God is fulfilling his promises, and they erupt into a violent outburst. So Jesus departs. How sad for them.

Every single Sunday at Mass, including this one, some version of this happens to many of us. God’s word announces the fulfillment of God’s promises in Christ, and we easily overlook or disdain it. His way is almost never according to our narrow expectations. What’s required of us is to set these aside, and to embrace a new openness to God’s gifts, no matter how he wishes to give them. God is fulfilling his promises the way He likes — why be sad?

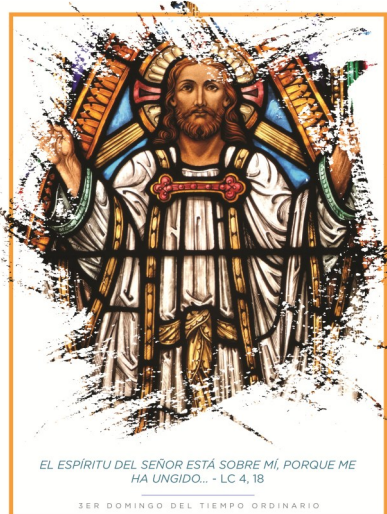

3ER DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO



Tenemos tantas cosas atrayentes y entretenidas que nos distraen grandemente. La televisión, la computadora, y sobre todo nuestro teléfono; podemos pasar el día entero viendo y buscando cosas que no nos llevan

a ningún lado. Cabe pues, que nos preguntemos lo siguiente: ¿Dónde ponemos nuestros ojos, nuestro pensamiento? Jesús, no tenía nada de estos instrumentos para anunciar el Reino de Dios. A Él se le entregó el rollo del Profeta Isaías, y leyó lo siguiente: “El Espíritu del Señor está sobre mí” (Lucas 4:18). Y ese mismo Espíritu de Dios está en nosotros, esperando que llegue un momento del día para estar juntos y mirarnos.

Toda la sinagoga estaba atenta con los ojos clavados en él. Y les dijo: “Hoy se cumplen estas palabras proféticas y a ustedes les llegan noticias de ello” (Lucas 4:21). “Cristo es el autor y guía de toda actividad evangélica que está expuesta. También la profecía predice que después de él sus propios discípulos serán los ministros de esta tarea cuando dice: “¡Qué hermosos son los pies del mensajero cuando anuncia la paz!” (Isaías 52:7).
